#### A New York Resolution for Remote Voting

The New York State Building Officials Conference, an ICC Chapter, Officers and Delegates have approved the attached resolution to send to the ICC Board of Directors concerning remote voting at ICC venues. It is the direction the ICC membership has clearly expressed that the ICC needs to go in.

The great success of the new electronic voting at the Board elections held in Orlando showed the Board that the members highly approved. Most of the members present seemed to agree that this is the correct direction for the ICC Board of Directors to be taking. The current plan is to use the same electronic voting capabilities at the final action hearings in Rochester.

It seems clear that the issue of remote voting should be moved to the forefront for the betterment of the entire ICC and it's membership.

This should be a grassroots/membership driven initiative with the same membership participation and involvement as the late ICC/IAPMO negotiations. We need to let the ICC Board of Directors know what the members think about remote voting. How much better than full participation in the whole process can you get? Remote voting! Yes, it's time.

NYSBOC wanted to contact NERC with sincere hope that NERC will support this resolution or can adopt a similar resolution supporting remote voting.
